## SPEAKING POINTS

### LEARNING TO HEAR GOD'S VOICE

Many women struggle to hear God's voice. Many also believe that God doesn't speak to them. This causes many women to live lives of doubt and uncertainty. Marissa teaches that God does speak to His daughters and that He wants a relationship with each one. Marissa explains how to listen to the prophetic voice of God through the many ways that He speaks: through His Word, through prayer, and through other people.

### DISCOVERING YOUR GIFTS

Every day, people question how they can make an impact on the world. People are wired to find what their gifts are and how they can use them to better those around them. Because many people either don't know what their gifts are or they don't know how to use them, they find themselves at an impasse and unable to find fulfillment. Marissa teaches that when you come to God and begin to learn His character, He shows you who you are and what gifts that He has given you. Once you learn to hear from God, spending time with Him enables you to discover your gifts. Marissa equips women with the tools necessary to dig into their God-given gifts and callings.

### PURSuing CONFIDENCE

Confidence is an issue that so many women face. Women inherently discredit themselves due to comparison, and they feel invaluable. They don't walk confidently in who God has made them to be because they don't know who they are in Him. Others have difficulty understanding how they fit in the world. When we're not confident, we aren't sharing with the world who God created us to be. Confidence in who God uniquely made you is necessary because if you can be confident, you can instill that confidence in others and empower and encourage other women to be that way.

Marissa believes that God wants us to live confidently. She teaches women to harness their unique, God-given identity so they can step out in the world with confidence.

### WALKING IN OBEDIENCE

As you learn to hear God's voice, you discover your gifts and you harness your confidence, the most critical step is to walk in obedience. Many people have issues with obedience because they are not sure that they hear God, aren't sure what He's called them to do and are not sure of who He made them to be. Marissa ties the lessons together by encouraging obedience. The goal is to serve God and serve people by obediently walking in their gifts and making an impact in the lives of others in their communities and the world around them. Marissa gives women the tools to use their gifts to build the God's Kingdom here on Earth.
